



Called Meeting
Tuesday July 13, 2026
Town Hall, Great Falls, SC

Councilmembers Present: Mayor Keevi Worthy, Councilmember Hope Sims, Mayor Por Tem Jody Knight, Councilmember Wytricia Mack, Councilmember Eric Owens, Councilmember David Dutton. A quorum was present.

Councilmembers Absent: Councilmember Monica Eagle

The public and media were duly notified of the date, time, and place of the meeting. Mayor Keevi Worthy called the Called meeting to order at 6:00PM, led the Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

ITEM 1 EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mayor Keevi Worthy called for the Council to enter Executive Session to receive legal advice regarding the Joshua Glenn matter. The motion to enter Executive Session was made by Mayor Keevi Worthy and seconded by Councilmember David Dutton. The motion carried unanimously.

Following Executive Session, Mayor Keevi Worthy made a motion to exit Executive Session, seconded by Councilmember David Dutton. The motion carried unanimously.

Upon returning to open session, the mayor announced that no action was taken during Executive Session.

The Council then considered legal representation for the Town regarding the Joshua Glenn case. A motion was made to retain Attorney Keith Marten as the Town Attorney to represent the Town specifically in the Joshua Glenn matter. The motion was seconded. The mayor called for discussion, and hearing none, called for a vote. The motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

Following the appointment of legal counsel, the Council discussed establishing official communication procedures to ensure all legal matters related to the Joshua Glenn case would be coordinated through designated representatives. Mayor Pro Tem Jody Knight

made a motion to designate Mayor Keevi Worthy as the Town's primary Point of Contact (POC) for all communications with Attorney Keith Marten. The motion further designated Jessica Eubanks, Mayor Assistant, as the secondary Point of Contact to assist with communications and to serve in the mayor's absence. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Hope Sims. There being no further discussion, the motion carried unanimously.

ITEM 2 ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting was adjourned.
